Project Name: Two-lane resurfacing (5705)

Communit: Hardin County

Project Description: Repave route SR37 from the Hancock County line to the Wyandot County line through the village of Forest and SR53 from the North Corporation limit of Kenton to SR37 in Hardin County due to pavement deterioration

Project Sponsor: Ohio Dept. of Transportation

Community Economic Distress Factors: Hardin County has been designated as both a high unemployment rate 6.42% and \$23,429 is the average median income.

Economic Development Potential: Project will create construction and material supplier jobs related to the construction activities.

Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor: The rehabilitation of this pavement is being done for safety and restoration of ride-ability purposes. Portions of these routes will be paved using crumb rubber from ground tires.

Work to Begin: Summer 2009

Estimated Completion: Fall 2009

Stimulus Investment: \$291,000

Total Project Cost: \$1,545,526
