Project Name: Two-lane Resurfacing Project (6340)

Community: Putnam County

Project Description: Repave routes SR189 and SR190 through the village of Ft. Jennings from the west corporation limits to US224 and SR694 from SR115 to the west corporation limit of the village of Glandorf in Putnam County due to pavement deterioration

Project Sponsor: Ohio Dept. of Transportation

Community Economic Distress Factors: Putnam County has been designated as a high unemployment rate 11.9% county and the median income is \$46,426.

Economic Development Potential: Putnam County's largest employment base is agriculture followed by manufacturing. There are auto parts and appliance manufacturers located in Putnam County.

Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor: The rehabilitation of this pavement is being done for safety and restoration of ride-ability purposes. The improvements will also aid farmers in getting their crops to market.
