



## 4-lane Pavement Rehabilitation/Wyandot County



**Project Name** (ID Number): Four-lane pavement Rehabilitation Project (6168)

**Community:** Wyandot County

**Project Description:** Grind and pave deteriorated pavement on US23 from County Road 62 to the CSX railroad.

**Project Sponsor:** ODOT District One

**Community Economic Distress Factors:** Wyandot County has been designated as a High Unemployment rate 7.03% county as well as a low income \$27,407.

**Economic Development Potential:** This particular section of US 23 carries 22,000 vehicles per day and serves as an important intermodal connector. Goods from Canada and shipments through the Port of Toledo are carried into the southeastern United States via US 23.

**Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor:** The grinding and paving of this section of US23 is necessary to maintain a safe and efficient travel surface for the traveling public. If the surface is not repaired, then further deterioration will occur, causing excess wear to vehicles on the roadways. The existing pavement has outlived its expected life due to repeated exposure to salt and grit during winter maintenance activities as well as vehicular loadings.

**Work to Begin:** Summer 2009

**Estimated Completion:** Fall 2009

**Stimulus Investment:** \$500,000

**Total Project Cost:** \$2,958,140
