



State Route 66 Resurfacing Fulton County



Project Name: State Route 66, Resurfacing (13410)

Community : Fulton County, Village of Archbold

Project Description: Resurfacing of State Route 66, S. Defiance Street, within the Village of Archbold from West Barre Road (CR C) north to the Norfolk-Southern Railway. This section of roadway was reconstructed by ODOT in the early 1960's and has received overlays, resulting in the loss of curb reveal. Current surface conditions are poor and the curbs are in poor condition. This project will eliminate potholes and replace the crumbling curbs.

Project Sponsor: Village of Archbold

Community Economic Distress Factors: High unemployment rate 7.25% and an average annual income of \$31,295.

Economic Development Potential: Resurfacing is necessary to maintain the useful life of this highway. SR 66 is a major transportation route for the Sauder Woodworking, Sauder Manufacturing, ConAgra Foods, Bil-jax Inc., business establishments in the local community. The project will allow for improved flow of truck traffic in the Village of Archbold.

Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor: State Route 66 is a vital route for national businesses in the Village of Archbold. This project would maintain this transportation artery as a shipping route to gain access to the Ohio Turnpike, Toledo Express Airport and the Port of Toledo and could lead to the development of additional economic growth in the area.

Work to Begin: 31-90 days

Estimated Completion: 4 months

Stimulus Investment: \$240,000

Total Project Cost: \$294,171
