



SR-302 Bridge Replacement, Ashland County

Project Name: State Route 302 Bridge Replacement Project (6351)

Community: Ashland County

Project Description: This project will replace a deficient 3-span steel beam bridge over the Muddy Fork on State Route 302, 0.19 mile west of Township Road 63, in Perry Township. This is east of the community known as Red Haw. The bridge deck is 3,003 square-feet.

Project Sponsor: Ohio Department of Transportation

Community Economic Distress Factors: Ashland County has a jobless rate of 6.6% and an annual average income of \$25,468.

Economic Development Potential: This community is near the U.S. Route 42 corridor in Ashland County that leads to both the City of Ashland and the City of West Salem in Wayne County. Both are near interchanges with Interstate 71, which makes this area good for future business, home, and/or agricultural development.

Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor: SR-302 is near U.S. 42 and connects to I-71 via State Route 301, State Route 539, or U.S. Route 250. This makes this community well positioned to access northern and southern parts of Ohio.

Work to Begin: in 31-90 days

Estimated Completion: 4 months

Stimulus Investment: \$439,070
