



North Street Bridge Replacement, Huron County



Project Name : Replacement of North Street Bridge Number NH 253-0.39 (13048)

Community: Huron County, Village of Plymouth

Project Description: Replacement of the North Street Bridge in the Village of Plymouth. The existing bridge is in very poor condition, has an ODOT bridge appraisal rating of 2P and a load limit of 20 tons. The project includes minor roadway improvements to widen the road to meet the new bridge. The new approach guardrails will tie into the new bridge rails.

Project Sponsor: Huron County Engineer

Community Economic Distress Factors: (county jobless rate, annual average income) Huron County has a high jobless rate of 8.96% and a low annual average income of \$26,432.

Economic Development Potential: This project has the potential of providing construction and material supply jobs.

Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor: The new bridge will improve access along North Street for the area residents, eliminate concerns of the fire and bus traffic, provide a wider, safer structure and provide construction and material jobs. The wider approach roadway will increase visibility at the bridge. The Village of Plymouth is just south of U.S. Route 224, a major east/west roadway, and near rail lines.

Work to Begin: in 120 days

Estimated Completion: 14 weeks

Stimulus Investment: \$210,000

Total Project Cost: \$247,882
