



Bucyrus Downtown Renovation, Crawford County



Project Name: Bucyrus Downtown Renovation Project

Community: City of Bucyrus, Crawford County

Project Description: This project involves the full reconstruction of State Route 4/State Route 98 (Sandusky Avenue) through Downtown Bucyrus. The 0.51 mile long project begins at Charles Avenue and concludes at the Sandusky River Bridge. The roadway is one lane in each direction, with a dual left-turn lane in the middle, and parking on both sides of the street. There are six signalized intersections within the project limits. The project goes through the heart of the community's downtown business district and is the location for the annual Bucyrus Bratwurst Festival every August. The project will replace traffic signals; install nostalgic street lighting and new curbs and gutters. The City of Bucyrus is also replacing its Storm Sewer System and water lines in conjunction with this project.
