Project Name: South Broadway Rehabilitation Project (7046)

Community: Lorain County, City of Lorain

Project Description: The project proposes to mill and resurface 0.422 miles of South Broadway Ave., between Cooper Foster Parkway (State Route 611) and the State Route 2 interchange, in the City of Lorain. Other work includes replacing curbs and gutters, constructing two 300-foot deceleration lanes, repairing storm inlets, and other improvements.

Project Sponsor: City of Lorain

Community Economic Distress Factors: (county jobless rate, annual average income) Lorain County has a jobless rate of 6.76% an annual average income of \$30,625.

Economic Development Potential: This project will create jobs in the construction industry in both the concrete and asphalt industries. Materials may be purchased locally such as concrete, asphalt, castings, fuel, etc.

Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor: The completed project will provide a smoother ride, smoother flow of traffic; the new deceleration lanes will prevent the ripple effect to asphalt pavement caused by dynamic loading. New pavement markings will delineate traffic better.
