



SR-301 Bridge Rehabilitation, Wayne County



Project Name: State Route 301 Bridge Rehabilitation Project (5690)

Community: Wayne County

Project Description: This project will rehabilitate a deficient 302-foot 3-span bridge over Interstate 71. The bridge deck is 9,289 square-feet. I-71 is six lanes.

Project Sponsor: Ohio Department of Transportation

Community Economic Distress Factors: Wayne County has a jobless rate of 5.26% and an annual average income of \$28,020.

Economic Development Potential: The SR-301 bridge over I-71 is critical to nearby businesses in West Salem, Wayne County and those along the U.S. Route 42 corridor in Ashland, Medina, and Wayne Counties who ship goods and materials via I-71 to and from Columbus and southern Ohio.

Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor: The SR-301 bridge and its interchange at I-71 is important to the businesses nearby and SR-301 connects to rail and other modes of transportation as it heads north into Medina and Lorain Counties.

Work to Begin: in 31-90 days

Estimated Completion: 2010

Stimulus Investment: \$1,519,660
