



State Route 539/Interstate 71 Overpass Upgrade



Project Name: State Route 539 Bridge Deck Replacement (PID 18242)

Community: Wayne County

Project Description: This project will rehabilitate a 282' bridge on State Route 539 over Interstate 71 in northwestern Wayne County. The project is between Ruff Road and Palmer Road. It will include a 135-day closure and the detour route will follow U.S. Route 42 and State Route 604. Depending on the availability of materials, this project may take up to nine months to complete.

The SR-539/I-71 interchange is south of the Village of West Salem, a growing community for economic development opportunities in Ashland, Medina, and Wayne Counties because of its proximity to both major north/south routes and east/west corridors in Ohio. SR-539 has an average daily traffic (ADT) of 1,590 vehicles per day and I-71 has 44,470 per day.
