



Sherrick Road SE Stabilization

Project Name: Sherrick Road SE stabilization (5522)

Community: Stark County/City of Canton

Project Description: The Sherrick Road stabilization project includes the injection of High Density Polyurethane (HDPE) Foam columns to stabilize the sanitary sewer trench; install ADA compliant curb ramps; and the profiling/resurfacing of the roadway full width. The project length is 3,460 linear feet (0.656 mile) with an average width of 30 feet. The sanitary sewer trench runs the length of the project aligned with the center of the roadway.

Project Sponsor: City of Canton

Community Economic Distress Factors: Stark County unemployment rate is 10.6 %; the annual average income is \$29,734

Economic Development Potential: Sherrick Rd. is such a highly traveled roadway by commuters, the trucking industry, and school buses that the very poor condition of the roadway creates unsafe situations. This project will provide a safer highway that allows the many modes of transportation (cars, buses, trucks) to continue using it.

Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor: Besides normal public traffic, Sherrick Road is a heavily-traveled public transit bus route, school bus route, and trucking distribution route. There are schools and a Community Center on this roadway.

Work to Begin: 3-6 months

Estimated Completion: 30 to 60 days after start of construction

Stimulus Investment: \$1,246,332

Total Project Cost: \$1,246,332
