



## Springfield Resurfacing and ADA Ramps/ City of Springfield

**Project Name:** Springfield Resurfacing and ADA Ramps (6981)

**Community:** City of Springfield/Clark County

**Project Description:** Improving the roadways and making sure the access points are ADA compliant is what this project will do for the city of Springfield. Five roadways in all will be resurfaced and new new ADA curb ramps will be installed The roadways are Sunset Avenue from John Street to Burnett Road; John Street from Fountain Avenue to Clifton Avenue; Fountain Avenue from High Street to Pleasant Street; Pleasant Street from Fountain Avenue to Limestone Street; Columbus Avenue from Belmont to the IORY railroad.

**Project Sponsor:** The City of Springfield

**Community Economic Distress Factors:** Clark County jobless rate is 9.6%

**Economic Development Potential:** Improving and preserving roadways in our cities makes them more attractive for businesses, residents, employees and visitors. Drivers have a smoother safer ride and ADA compliant curb ramps make the city more accessible.

**Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor:** This will provide greater access to downtown Springfield. Easier and safer travel for all modes of transportation including everything from tractor trailers moving commerce to cyclists and pedestrians. These roadway improvements provide better connectivity locally and to the region.
