



SR 571 Pavement Rehabilitation Darke County



Project Name: State Route 571 Pavement Rehabilitation, Darke County (6303)

Community: Darke County

Project Description: The project will resurface 4.5 miles of SR 571 near the Darke/Miami County Line, specifically between the City Greenville and the Village of West Milton. This route is heavily traveled by truck traffic going to the Ethanol Plant in Greenville. The current pavement condition rating (PCR) is 69. The work will be a minor rehabilitation of the existing pavement, including some berm stabilization to address pavement drop offs for safety.

Project Sponsor: Ohio Department of Transportation

Community Economic Distress Factors: The Darke County jobless rate is 11.8%, and the median income is \$39,307.

Economic Development Potential: Darke County is home to several major manufacturers including Whirlpool, Mid Mark Corporation, the makers of medical and dental equipment and Greenville Technical, which manufactures plastics for automobiles. State Route 571 is considered one of the major routes for the transportation of these goods to market.

Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor: In addition to creating a smoother driving surface, the road will help connect motorists from and freight movement between communities and markets. CSX railroad also operates in Darke County, and improving the road surface will impact rail business as well.

Work to Begin: 31 to 90 days

Estimated Completion: two weeks

Stimulus Investment: \$510,000

Total Project Cost: \$620,292
