Project Name: I-75 Resurfacing Project from the Montgomery/Miami County Line to the North Corporation Limit of Tipp City (5913)

Community: Miami County

Project Description: Improving travel and providing better connectivity is what this project will do. 5 miles of roadway will be resurfaced from the Montgomery/Miami county line to Tipp City in Miami County.

Project Sponsor: Ohio Department of Transportation

Community Economic Distress Factors: Miami County jobless rate is 11.3%

Economic Development Potential: This project will preserve the current highway system making it safer for motorists and businesses to transport loved ones and goods and services. This five mile stretch of freeway includes major distribution centers for Honda Manufacturing of America and Meijer. There are also smaller retail shops and businesses that serve the community and visitors.

Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor: I-75 is a major thoroughfare through the entire State of Ohio for the trucking industry as well as the general public.

Work to Begin: 31 to 90 days

Estimated Completion: 4 months after project commencement

Stimulus Investment: \$1,800,000
