



# James H. McGee Boulevard Reconstruction City of Dayton

**Project Name:** James H. McGee Boulevard Rehabilitation (8896)

**Community:** Montgomery County, City of Dayton

**Project Description:** This project will restore and preserve a major thoroughfare for residents and businesses using the heavily traveled James H. McGee Boulevard. Construction work will resurface the boulevard and make repairs caused which will result in improved safety, reduce wear and tear on vehicles and less maintenance costs.

**Project Sponsor:** City of Dayton

**Community Economic Distress Factors:** The county jobless rate is 11.2%

**Economic Development Potential:** This project will bring economic stimulus to the Dayton community by employing approximately 40 people who would not have work to do otherwise. This project will bring construction work to the area.

**Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor:** James H. McGee Boulevard links US Route 35 to Kammer Avenue where several businesses are located in Dayton. Improving this roadway is significant because it is a better link for businesses to the region and state. Truckers move freight from I-75 and US Route 35 to the area.

**Work to Begin:** approximately 6 months

**Estimated Completion:** 9 months after project commencement

**Stimulus Investment:** \$1,180,169

**Total Project Cost:** \$1,180,169
