



Woodman Drive/Linden Avenue Improvements City of Riverside

Project Name: Woodman Drive/Linden Avenue Improvements (8899)

Community: Montgomery County, City of Riverside

Project Description: The project consists of infrastructure repairs along Woodman Drive from north of US 35 and Linden Avenue to the community of Beavercreek. The improvement work in both areas include milling and asphalt overlay with full depth concrete joint and base repairs; new striping; raised pavement marker installation; and loop detector replacements (for traffic signals).

Project Sponsor: City of Riverside

Community Economic Distress Factors: The county jobless rate is 11.2%

Economic Development Potential: Improving the roadway surface makes these routes safer and creates better access for local businesses.

Multi-Modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor: Both Woodman Drive and Linden Avenue are major thoroughfares within Riverside that provide direct, continuous and vital access between communities within the greater Dayton and surrounding areas. Local businesses need improved and safer routes for local residents and visitors.
