



SR 47 Culvert Replacement Shelby County



Project Name: SR 47 Culvert Reconstruction, Shelby County (5693)

Community: Shelby County

Project Description: This project is to replace a heavily deteriorated 9'x5' concrete culvert. The project is located 0.87 miles east of the Darke/Shelby county line. This section of SR 47 runs between the Village of Versailles and the City of Sidney.

Project Sponsor: Ohio Department of Transportation

Community Economic Distress Factors: Shelby County jobless rate is 11.7% and the median income is \$44,507.

Economic Development Potential: Farming is Shelby County's first, primary and most basic industry. More than 200,000 acres in the county are used to grow soybeans, corn and wheat. The Cargill plant in nearby Sidney processes soybeans for cooking oil and mayonnaise.

Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor: SR 47 is a major thoroughfare between Sidney and Versailles. This route is heavily traveled by trucks delivering goods to and from manufacturers.

Estimated Completion: November 2009

Stimulus Investment: \$146,678
