Project Name: State Route 380 (5939)

Community: Clinton County,

Project Description: Resurface State Route 380 from Greene County to Highland County

Project Sponsor: ODOT

Community Economic Distress Factors: 10.3 percent, \$40,467; in addition, DHL is pulling out of Wilmington, taking with it 8,000 to 10,000 jobs.

Economic Development Potential: Businesses located near and within city of Wilmington rely on moderate to heavy highway shipping to and from Interstate 71 by way of SR 380. SR 380 also provides access for regional residents to Wilmington College, Clinton Memorial Hospital, and the Southern State Community College.

Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor: Interstate 71, which is a major thoroughfare through the heart of Ohio, can be accessed by way of SR 380, providing highway shipping access for local businesses within the city of Wilmington and Clinton County to the metropolitan regions of Columbus, Cincinnati and Cleveland. SR 380 is a connector route for Caesar's Creek State Park, and Caesar Creek Flea Market, the Ohio Renaissance Village, all of which draw hundreds of visitors to the region.
