Project Name (ID Number): Dayton-Yellow Springs Road Resurfacing (9156)

Community (County/City): Greene County, Fairborn

Project Description: Resurface Dayton-Yellow Springs Road from Kauffman Avenue to Ironwood Drive to improve pavement condition

Project Sponsor: City of Fairborn

Community Economic Distress Factors: (county jobless rate, annual average income) 8.9 per cent; \$33,743

Economic Development Potential: Roadway, which has a functional classification of an urban minor arterial, is in poor condition, and the surface is in need of repair. It would help improve the roadway infrastructure for the city of Fairborn.

Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor: The city of Fairborn is analyzing the roadway to see if a 4- or 5-foot bike path could be installed on both sides of the roadway just inside of the curb. This bike path would be installed using pavement markings consisting of an edge line and bicycle designations. Currently, there is no parking permitted on either side of this roadway, so this road would be a good candidate for providing additional lanes for the bikeway system in the Miami Valley area.
