



## Adams County Resurfacing

**Project Name:** Lloyd and Blue Creek Road Resurfacing Project (5873)

**Community:** Adams County, various county road locations

**Project Description:** This project calls for resurfacing County Road 70 (Lloyd Road) and County Road 18 (Blue Creek Road), for a total of 0.90 miles of a Rural Major Collector Route and 4.38 miles of a Rural Minor Collector Route. While addressing significant pavement deficiencies, this project will serve to maintain the integrity of the existing route, preserve the county's infrastructure, and improve the safety of the route for the traveling public. In addition, the project will enable Adams County to utilize internal and other external funds for necessary resurfacing and preservation of its total county highway system (380 miles). This cost offset would be realized over the estimated 15-year useful life of this project.

**Project Sponsor:** Adams County Engineer's Office

**Community Economic Distress Factors:** This is an economically distressed area in which the unemployment rate is 8.48 percent, and the per capita income is \$23,013.

**Economic Development Potential:** Adams County is an economically depressed area, and this project will enable the county to create 24 jobs while realizing significant cost savings to the county. Thus, the money saved by the county can be used toward other projects that will play a vital role in preserving the county's infrastructure and developing economic growth.

**Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor:** C.R. 70 (Lloyd Road) is closely linked to West Union, the county seat, via S.R. 125, and C.R. 18 (Blue Creek Road) provides connectivity to the U.S. 52 corridor, the county's primary east-west route along the Ohio River, as well as to state routes 125, 348 and 781 - all of which serve as viable commercial and passenger links from eastern Adams County to Scioto County. Preserving this infrastructure will enhance this connectivity and promote safer, more efficient travel to the business and industry communities and educational and medical institutions in West Union, as well as to those in Scioto County.
