Project Name: State Route 9 Rehabilitation (5715)

Community: Harrison County

Project Description: Fifteen miles of asphalt resurfacing and base repairs on SR 9 as well as six miles of asphalt resurfacing and chip sealing on SR 799 in Harrison County.

Project Sponsor: Ohio Department of Transportation, District 11

Community Economic Distress Factors: 6.85% unemployment rate, \$24,494 average annual income

Economic Development Potential: SR 9 in Harrison County is the major north-south route used to move goods and services in the area.

Multi-modal Connectivity/Innovation Factor: On this project, District 11 is utilizing chip seal as a bond breaker between the existing asphalt and the final layer of asphalt which is an innovative technique used to extend the pavement life.

Work to Begin: Within 90 days

Estimated Completion: Six months

Stimulus Investment: \$107,902

Total Project Cost: \$116,770
