



E. 14th Street Streetscape Project



Project Name: E. 14th Street Streetscape Project

Community: Cleveland, Cuyahoga County

Project Description: The proposed project involves roadway and streetscape improvements including sidewalks, paving, trees, plants and benches along East 14th Street, from Prospect Avenue to Euclid Avenue.

Other proposed improvements to the streetscape will include:

- Shade trees in raised planters similar to the approach for Euclid Avenue
- Wide sidewalks for pedestrians walking between the theaters, restaurants, and parking
- Bands of brick unit pavers on the east side (the theater side) of the street that would match the brick unit pavers on Euclid Avenue; the west side of the street would use the brick unit pavers in Star Plaza to extend that open space into East 14th Street
- LED (light emitting diode) light strips integrated into the pavement (i.e. colored bricks mosaic) to further reinforce the connection between the theaters
- Site furnishings, like benches, for patrons waiting to be picked up or to meet friends
- Lighted bollards at the theater entrances
- Decorative lighting and lighted crosswalks
- Public art, enhanced signage and way finding signs
