



## **Kamm's Corners Streetscape Improvements, Phase III**



**Project Name:** Kamm's Corners Streetscape Improvements, Phase III

**Community:** Cleveland, Cuyahoga County

**Project Description:** The Lorain Avenue Streetscape Improvement Project is transforming Kamm's Corners' "downtown."

"Phase III," using Federal Stimulus dollars, consists of improvement of approximately 0.65 miles of SR 10 (Lorain Avenue) between the City of Cleveland west corporation limit (WCL) and West 165th Street. The improvements located between the WCL and Groveland Avenue include decorative curb, sidewalk, crosswalks, street lighting, traffic signals, signing and the relocation of aerial utilities into underground conduit systems. The improvements located between Groveland Avenue and West 165th Street include the addition of decorative crosswalks and clay paver sidewalk accents.

The Lorain Avenue Streetscape Improvement Project further energizes and accelerates the continued improvement of the Kamm's Corners neighborhood. Already, this substantial public investment is drawing new businesses, residents, and visitors to the neighborhood and is enhancing property values.
