Qualified Product List Specification - Requirements

ODOT Construction and Materials Specifications 705.12

Requirements for inclusion on the Qualified Product List (QPL)

Submit to the Office of Materials Management the following information:

1. Follow the requirements of Departmental Supplement 1001 and ASTM C494.
Ensure that the minimum relative durability factor is 90.

Acceptance by the Department

The Office of Materials Management will review a manufacturer's submittal for compliance with specification requirements and will evaluate any pre-qualification samples.

Accepted products will be listed on the Department's Qualified Product List web page and will be loaded into the Department's Construction Management System for acceptance in the field through the QPL screen.

Field Documentation requirements

Products on the QPL will be accepted if they can be identified in the field by a supplier/manufacturer listed on the Department's Qualified Products List

Provide re-certification documentation by January 1 each calendar year by submitting a written agreement, certifying the material is not altered or changed from that originally approved. Including with the letter, the quality control value in tabular form, for each product manufactured the prior year and technical data sheet with dosage rate per type. List each uniformity test as a minimum,, maximum and average.

The manufactures will resubmit certified data and samples with any notification of change.
