Item 202 note on 19/39 prohibits the use of hoe-rams for removal of the existing structure. Is it the intent that the whole structure be demolished with 90-pound hammers when none of the existing structure is to be incorporated in the proposed structure?

Question Number: 2

On plan sheet no. 19 - Portions of Structure Removed, over 20 foot span, as per plan, prohibits the use of hoe-rams for the demolition of the bridge. Since this structure will be sawcut between the two phases, it seems that this note is not applicable and will add considerable cost to the structure removal if 90 pound hammers must be used.

This project calls for the use of QC/QA Concrete. Because of the phasing and many small pours, the cost of testing will result in a substantially increased cost per cubic yard of concrete.

This issue was addressed by previous addendum.
