Item 15, truncated domes, If these are glue downs on existing walk why is there orange fence and why do some have curb removal and no replacement and why is this done after pavement planing if ramp elvations are not changing?

The construction fence will still be necessary to keep pedestrians out of the area while the work is being done. The curb directly in front of the walk is to be removed at the locations specified to make the walk traversable. The area of the removed curb will be covered with asphalt when the approach roadway is paved. The pavement planing is required to be completed first to avoid damaging the new truncated domes.
