We understand that the bridge survey was done via scanning equipment; however the Bridge Scan Survey DGN file and Bottom of Beam Spreadsheet posted to the FTP site seem incomplete. What should the DBT expect to receive in terms of the bridge survey for design? (For example the bridge deck features, such as parapets, are missing from the DGN file, will these be included in the final bridge survey to be received from District 8?)

Upon award of the contract to the low bidder, a DGN file will be provided that includes the existing deck edges, parapet lines, abutments, wingwalls and deck profile. If, after the contract has been awarded, the Contractor wants the bottom of beam elevations the BOB request form posted to the FTP must be completed and submitted to ODOT.

Will the contractor be permitted to maintain traffic on a portion of the structure supported by only two beams?

Preference should always be given to alternatives that would avoid maintaining traffic on only two beams. However, if there is no other viable alternative traffic may be maintained on a portion of the structure that is supported by only two beams. The maintenance of traffic design must be in accordance with the design manuals and follow the review process as described in the bid documents.
