Is it either included in the Select Granural Backfill (paid by Cy) or is it cover by the Foundation Preparation (paid by SY)? If it is cover by the Foundation Preparation item then shouldn't it be stated in the proposal as a (As Per Plan) since the supplemental spec 840 part 'D' states "Spread, place and compact 12" of granular Type C on top of the geotextile fabric according to the requirements of 204.07." Could you please clarify how these items are being paid for? Also there was a previous question asking how Item 203 Granular material, Type B is being paid for in what reference item?
