Per your Maintenance of Traffic Typical Sections on Plan page 12/40, you show a tappered longitudinal jt that seperates Phase 1 from Phase 2. Per your plan there will be a 5" difference in grade in lane 2. Thats a 5" grade change in 8.5 feet (11'-width of barrel). Your plan note on page 8/40 states that 1" in 10' is required. 4 lanes will not be able to be maintained for both Phase 1 and Phase 2 unless the minimum grade change is not waived.

The 1" per 10' applies to transverse joints. The preceding paragraph states that a 6:1 is required for longitudinal joints. The joint required to remove and construct the overlay between lanes is a longitudinal joint, hence a 6:1 wedge is needed. Using the numbers provided by the bidder, I arrive at a 20:1 for 5" in 8.5'. The wedge only needs to be 30" wide to meet the plan requirement
