The 2 lane routes in Geauga County have excessive cracking outside the lane edge line, to the edge of pavement. Is it the intent of this contract to fill all the cracks outside the edge line into the berm.

The estimated square yard quantities for Item 423 on the 2 lane routes in Geauga County include the shoulder areas as well as the lanes. Please bid accordingly. On severely cracked shoulders, the intent is to seal as many of the most severe cracks as possible, but in a manner that allows for exposed pavement between bands of cracksealing material. It is not the intent of this project to seal severely cracked shoulders so much that large bands of cracksealing material are applied side by side resulting in wide applications of material on and along the pavement surface.

All prospective bidders, subcontractors, suppliers, materialmen and all others who have an interest in these prebid questions and answers are advised that these items are being provided for informational purposes only and are not part of the bidding documents. If a question warrants a clarification, the Department will issue an addenda addressing the request for clarification to all plan holders. If the Department believes that the bidding documents adequately address the request, the contractor will be advised accordingly.
