Is the most recently submitted form the one that governs? What security measures are being taken to prevent a form being submitted on behalf of another? Can there be multiple proposed base bid manufacturers listed on a given line? What is the information to be used for? Can the information, if provided properly, be used to change the outcome/award of a bid?
