The Plan Notes for Bid Reference 100 (Controller Unit, Type TS2/A2, With Cabinet, Type TS2, AS Per Plan) contain Eagle part numbers for the cabinet (EL 712) and the load bay (TF5016). Is an Eagle spec properly justified on this project or should these be replaced with a generic spec?

The plan note "Item 633 Controller Unit, TS2/A2, with cabinet..." on page 45 indicates models for the enclosure and the terminal facility but does not indicate a model designation for the controller. The last paragraph of the plan note states: "Preparation of the enclosure and terminal facility shall be in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions." Should the contractor be required to provide the enclosure and terminal facility?
