Bid item 43 644 Curb Marking 175 FT You can not put thermoplastic on a curb. The material needs to be changed.

The maintenance of traffic for work on SR 7 call for removal of existing markings, placement of temporary paint markings (Ref # 50 thru 56), removal of temporary markings, and placement of permanent Thermo Marking (Ref # 37 thru 46). The area that has all of the marking work done does not receive an asphalt overlay. Therefore there will be several sets of lines which will be placed and removed, damaging a two year old pavement (ODOT Project 439(03) performed in 2004). Would temporary markings using a 740.06 tape product be a better option? Since the existing markings are to be removed as shown on page 6 of the plans, should there be 642 or 644 Removal of Pavement Marking Item? Page 10 of the plans-General Summary shows a quantity for 32" Portable Concrete Barrier of 420 L.F. on page 9. When looking at page 9, no wall is shown but PCB Offsets are given. Can a general layout of the wall required and a breakdown of wall needed for phase 3 & 4 be given?
