The addendum issued on 2/10/06 changes the 144" Liner Plate to a .2092 minimum thickness. The original item description held that "base metal composition, depth and span of the corrugations, and size and spacing of bolts and bolts holes shall be in accordance with the details of the manufactuer". Why the change to .2092" thickness when a more economical thickness in a particular type of Liner Plate would be structurally acceptable? In specifing only one minimum thickness requirement for only one of the types of Liner Plate commercially available ODOT has likely eliminated any material cost savings associated with the different types of Liner Plate. Is this ODOT's intention or would a lighter thickness in a more efficient Liner Plate design be considered?

The District believes that the minimum thickness required is necessary.
