In regards to the Heat Straightening on Bridge No. HAM-126-1950 the plans refer to Supplemental Spec 849, but the pay items outlined in the specification are not listed. How are the items; Item 849E10000 - Damage Assessment, Item 849E10500 - Surface Preparation, Item 849E10600 - Repairing Damaged members by Grinding, Item 849E10700 - Straightening Damaged Members, as stated in the SS 849 paid? Are the previous items included with Item 513E19000 Special- Heat Straightening of Damaged Structural Steel?

A:The reference to Supplemental Spec 849 provides all the requirements for the method of repair. Per note Item 513 - SPECIAL - HEAT STRAIGHTENING OF DAMAGED STRUCTURAL STEEL on sheet 5 of 17, payment for all the below shall be at the unit price bid per lump sum for item Special - Heat Straightening of Damaged Structural Steel, which shall include all labor, equipment, materials and incidentals necessary to complete the above work. Previous items noted in the prebid question shall be included with Item 513E19000 Special - Heat Straightening of Damaged Structural Steel.

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Question Number: 2

The Lane Value Contract Table from the plans, identify a disinsentive cost. The ODOT Permitted Lane Closure website shows permitted closure from 7pm to 6am (weekday construction), at what time does the disinsentive cost come into effect?

The contract shall reference the permitted lane closure map for for each individual structure. The disinsentive cost will come into effect prior to and after the permitted closure time.
