On page 9 of plans the pavement repair area for Gifford State Forest is 5,000 S.Y. of 6". In the plans there is only one area in Gifford Park specifically referenced to have work performed (Plan page 55) and the pavement area is only 1897 S.Y. Are there other areas in Gifford Park that get repair and if so what is the location of the areas? Please clarify if the 5000 S.Y. quantity of pavement repair is correct.
