Page 8/77 MOT notes that between 7-9 and 3-6 2 lanes of traffic need to be maintained in each direction. sheets 9-12/77 show a permanent one lane closure with 1 lane maintained. is it allowed to maintain one lane of traffic in this section for the duration of the widening work also during above mentioned hours?

**Per the note on Sheet 8/77, 2 lanes of traffic must be maintained in each direction between 7-9am and 3-6pm. Outside of these restrictions, 1 lane may be closed any other time using the MOT details shown on Sheets 9-12/77.**

In the notes on plan page 29/77, it notes to have an IMSA Level 2 certified tech on site. We are requesting this to be removed. This does not give a contractor any more qualification than a state electrical license and experience. If we are already prequalified with ODOT to do this type of work, then that should be all that is required. In addition, this qualification has never been a standard practice for ODOT on other similar projects either. Please advise as soon as possible, so we can proceed accordingly.

**Answer: An IMSA Level 2 Certified Traffic Signal Technician is required during the performance of any signal related construction operations. Please bid accordingly.**

Bid Reference # 136, 137, & 138 are proprietary preemption base bid items for intersections located in Willoughby Hills. Does Willoughby Hills have 50% of its existing signalized intersections operating with the proprietary specified Opticom equipment, per the requirements of the OHIO TEM section 120-4? It is our belief that Willoughby Hills has less than the required 50% to have this as a proprietary base bid specification. Will an addendum be issued to remove the proprietary brand equipment that is specified for these base bid items?
