This project calls for rpm reflector. Does this mean the old casting will not be removed and we will be replacing only the reflector? Will the contractor apply chip and seal around the old casting and not over the existing rpm? please clarify this item.

**Existing RPM are not to be removed. Contractor is to replace reflectors in the existing RPM's under Ref. No. 0002 after completion on Single Chip Seal under Ref. No. 0001. Contractor must determine the methods and means that he will use Methods and means of preparing existing RPM castings for the placement of reflector after application of chip seal by either protecting existing RPM castings during application of chip seal and/or by cleaning chip seal material from the casting after it is applied.**
