Per the 2005 CMS manual the contractor may have the option to substitute a 3-Sided Precast Culvert placed on a cast in place slab bottom for a four sided box structure when shown on the plans. If a 3 sided precast arch culvert were to be provided in place of the box, would the use of pre approved precast concrete wingwalls be allowed as per the 2005 CMS instead of the Cellular Retaining Walls as per the plan notes?
