Page 3/39 has a ITEM 201 Clearing and Grubbing note that states that there are no trees marked for removal, but plan sheet 10/39 shows trees marked for removal. Page 4/39 has the "Indiana Bat Note" that states that no "Bat Trees" may be removed between April 1 and September 30. With a sale date of March 11 the contractor will not have a contract by April 1. How can the "Indiana Bat Note" regirements be fulfilled?

The trees marked for removal are less than 12" in diameter, and are therefore brush. They were inspected and none of them are bat trees so the time restriction will not apply.

What is the flow rate of the existing 8" sanitary sewer line?
