What is the work limit south of the Turnpike Interchange (ramps to and from I-80/I-76 only assuming no work on ramps to and from Mahonning Ave)? The scope says that the project limit is "the overhead sign truss east OTP WB Entrance ramp". There are two truss signs east of that location, please clarify which one is the eastern limit.

A1. Only on the I-76 and I-80 interchange ramps, not the Mahoning Ave ramps. A2. Per section 6- MAH-I80 - from SLM 0.00 to SLM $0.50\pm$

Please define more clearly the limits of signing work at the S.R. 11 & I-80 Interchange. Are any ramps to and from S.R. 711 included?

A. Section 16.2A & B states to replace all existing signs with new signs on all SR11 mainline and all interchange ramps. So the ramps to and from SR711 would be included.

It would seem that the requirements of a Type C Field Office is too much for this size of a project. Often there is no Field Office needed due to the short duration of actual construction.

The prebid meeting listed on page 3 of the scope of services indicates that it will be held on July 8, 2010 at District 4 HQ. This is 2 months after the scheduled bid opening. Since the prebid meetings on these rather basic Design Build projects are less informative, and often consist of little more than a rereading of the Scope of Services, it may be more prudent to do away with the prebid meeting for this project, and encourage interested bidders to submit any prebid questions as early as possible to allow ample opportunity for the Department to respond.

This project is limited to the replacement of the existing signing which is clearly inside the existing right of way. I-76 / 80 is a limited access facility with ROW fence already establishing the limits of the ROW. SR 11 is a limited access facility with ROW fence already establishing the ROW as well?
