The note on plan sheet 16 says that "Payment for any necessary excavation to place the aggregate shall be included in the price bid per cy.

Does ODOT mean that the excavation will be paid under one of the excavation items or that the necessary excavation is considered incidental to this bid item?

The necessary excavation for placing the aggregate backfill is included with the Roadway, Misc.: Aggregate Backfill pay item. The excavation is considered as incidental to this pay item. No separate payment will be made for excavation for the aggregate backfill.

After review of the roadway cross-sections, it appears that the engineer did not deduct the area for pavement removed from the excavation cross-section. This question was brought up at last year's prebid meeting for the original project 554(04) prior to it being deferred. The volume affected by this question could have a great impact on the true volume of excavation as well as to whether this project is an excess or borrow project. Will ODOT please verify sample cross-sections to check this and in turn determine what the proper excavation volume is?

Ref. 140,141,142- Plans call for 27"  $\times$  42" Class HE-II pipe. This is not a size of pipe that is readily made by the concrete pipe suppliers. Will ODOT please clarify what size of pipe shall be used?

We have reviewed your question and believe the the specified size can be obtained. The contractor may furnish that size of a slightly larger size (as approved by the engineer) with equivalent hydraulics. The 27" x 42" size should be considered the minimum acceptable.

There are several locations on the project where new culverts are to be constructed across SR 18. In more than a few cases, the drainage flow of the new conduits conflicts with the phasing of the maintenance of traffic. In other words, constructing the culverts per the MOT phasing will cause drainage backups, especially when the newly installed culverts are in the same trench line as old pipes to be removed (in some cases the newly installed lines are at a different elevation than that of the old line).

One example is the culvert shown on plan sheet 324.

How is the contractor to address this issue?

The contractor will provide temporary connections between old and new conduits between phases to maintain the drainage. The conduits in the same location and approximate depth will connect fairly easily. The conduits that are offset will require bends to connect temporarily.

In regards to installation of 615 pavement. Plan sheet 18 states that single lane operation shall not be allowed during hours of darkness or non-working hours. We are also restricted to closures not being permited between the hours of 6-9AM and 3-6PM Monday through Friday. Plan sheet 19A under trench for widening and over night trench closing we need to complete base widening to a depth of no more than 1.5" below the existing pavement. So to complete all work items for 615 pavement, we are limited to only a 6 hour work window. We must perform excavation, install 304 and various lifts of asphalt in this time frame. Under this restricted time frame it will take months to install 615 pavement. During other phases on this project traffic will limited to one lane for several months at a time. Why not allow the same lane closures for this item of work?

Plan sheet 18: Regarding the Temporary Pavement construction on the eastbound shoulder prior to stages 1,4,5- There is a general note stating that this work cannot be done during darkness or non-working hours. The non-working hours are defined as 6:00 am to 9:00 am and 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm Monday through Friday. Plan notes on sheet 19a require material placement ASAP behind grading operations with a maximum dropoff of 1.5". Given that the contractor will be required to place a 4" lift of 304 base and 6.25" of asphalt to get to the 1.5" dropoff within these times, will ODOT please consider easing up on the restrictions so that work can be performed an a more productive manner?

At the prebid meeting of September 28, 2004 there were a couple of prebid questions asked. To date, there has been no posted response to the questions. It is now within one week of the bid and no addendums have been issued. Will ODOT please respond to the prebid questions that were asked at the meeting?
