With a 7/13 bid date there will not even be a signed contract until the middle of August which does not leave sufficient time for shop drawing preparation and department review much less actual wall construction. Also, we have indications from various noisewall suppliers that they can not take on more work which would need to be supplied prior to the middle of 2006. Please consider revising the completion date to 9/30/2006.
