The utility note section of the proposal does not provide completion dates for all of the underground and aerial utility relocation. The relocation schedule is very important because the SR 104 closure has a \$2,500 per day incentive/disincentive. Please provide completion dates for the relocation of each utility company.

Sheet #11 shows a incentive/disincentive completion date of October 31, 2006, whereas, the final completion date for the project is August 31, 2007. Furthermore, for a contractor to get the full bonus he would have to have all the roads open by August 29, 2006 and that would require all the phases of work to be done in approx. 60 days. Why is there such a large time difference between the two dates? Also it would be impossible to get all phases of work done in less that 60 days - is the incentive/disincentive completion date correct?
