Regarding project 050572 US 422 Portage County, on page 30/31 of the Proposal, Note 121 – incentive/disincentive contract. It states, The contractor shall complete all critical work and safety items and have US 422 open to through traffic by 120 hours over two weekends. What items are designated as the critical work items that must be completed to open US 422 to through traffic?

We believe that PN 121 in the Proposal is very clear. "The following items are designated as critical work: US 422 open to through traffic." No other restrictions are place on the contractor.

To further clarify PN 121, Do the critical work items on this project, include roadway, erosion control, drainage, pavement planing and resurfacing, and traffic control items? As long as US 422 is open to through traffic by the end of the time restrictions these items of work may be completed under daily work zones as stated in the plan, per notes on page 8/22?
