On page 7 of your bid documentation (3rd paragraph) it states that "Portable Trailer Mounted Signals" are not to be used. We manufacture a portable traffic light system that matches and exceeds the features of a "temporary span mounted signal", including light heads that hang over the roadway and conflict monitoring. They just happen to be mounted on a trailer. Could you please inform me of the specifications that would need to be met in order for you to consider using a portable traffic system on this project.

Trailer mounted signals are not permitted because they do not include luminaires. Before trailer mounted signals would be considered they must include, as a permanent part of the trailer mounted equipment, a luminaire that meets all of the requirements for luminaires as described on Standard Construction Drawing MT-96.21. (The requirements include but are not limited to; luminaire type, mounting height and arm length)
