PG 17 has median drainage summary. There are no plan and profile pages associated with this work. Elevations are needed for the installation of the pipe and headwalls. Will this information be provided?

Page 89 of the proposal advises that bidders must perform work equal to at least fifty percent of the total amount of the submitted bid. Will this be reduced to allow non-paving contractors to bid the project as the prime contractor.

On plan page 10/144 in the center column, the note for Item 614 (LEO) indicates "During a traffic signal installation where blockage of traffic is required" a LEO is required and indicates this will be paid for under LEO w/Patrol Car (B/R # 0185). On plan page 92/144 in the right column indicates specific intersections where LEOs are required during an outage or malfunction. However the very last note, in the same section, indicates that this shall be included in the lump sum price for Maintaining Traffic (B/R # 0193). Under which bid reference number will the LEO be paid?
