1) Re. REF. 180, INTERM. TP 2 PG64-28: There appears to be a bust in the quantity. Wearing Course Removed quan.= 358 SY on this bridge. This corresponds to a 1 1/2" surface quantity of 15 CY (Ref. 181). The 1 1/2" intermediate covers the same footprint but the bid quantity is 4 CY (Ref. 180). It looks like they included the approach slabs but left the bridge deck out of the calculation.

2) Re. REF. 129 TEMPORARY PAVEMENT: Plan quantity of 660 SY is incorrect. On Sheet 9E the Subsummary quantity of 495 SY should read 173 SY. On Sheet 9D the linear measurement of 165 LF was carried to the subsummary as 165 SY. It should read 55 SY. The total plan quantity should be 228 SY.
