Proposal Note 420(Surface Smoothness) is specified for this project, but one area does not meet the designer note criteria. the following is the area in question USR 62 from SLM 22.58 to SLM 24.3 - 1.5" milling & 1.5" paving is specified - per designer note total pavement thickness must be greater than or equal to 2.25" - Shouldn't the note be removed from the project for this section? The other areas on the project from SLM 24.3 to SLM 25.49 are all in Corp. limits, the designer note states that PN 420 should not be used on 2 lane projects in Corp. limits. will the note still apply to this section? In regards to item 253 pavement repair, is it the Departments intent to repair areas of brick encountered after milling? The APP note for the Pavement Planing specifically states that the brick base is not to be disturbed. Please clarify. Will the Department allow the contractor to close one lane in each direction for the weekend work in section SLM 24.3 to 24.75 per the Maintenance of Traffic Notes, item 1, on pg. 8.
