Question Number: 4

In order to get a quotation for RR Protective Liability Insurance we need to describe the work to be performed within or adjacent to the RR right-of-way. This description should include the right-of-way limits relative to the work area and show the distance from active rails where work is to be performed. There is usually a General Note that addresses this question. I do not see such a note for this project. Please direct me to or provide this information.

As shown on the Pavement Calculations (sheets 20 & 21) the paving work is suspended at the railroad tracks. There will be a 50' gap in the resurfacing. Paving will stop 25 feet short of the tracks and resume 25 feet past the tracks.
